(numéroter les onomatopées de 1 à 8)</p> <p>- « Listen to the song and try to find the animal sounds » : écoute de la chanson les élèves écrivent sur leur cahier de brouillon le numéro des bruits dans l'ordre entendu + correction.</p> <p>5) <u>Trace écrite et fin de séance</u> :</p> <p>5' - relier les animaux à leur bruit (fiche individuelle) + questionnement : Which animal goes... ?</p> <p>15' - rangement des étiquettes + apprentissage de la chanson.</p>
